DIRECTIONS



BY ROAD

40 minutes from central London. Take the M40 Junction 2, or M4 Junction 7.

DIRECTIONS FROM M4/A4

If coming from M4 Junction 7, turn left at the roundabout onto the A4 towards Maidenhead. Go straight at the traffic lights and turn right at the roundabout (Sainsbury's supermarket) onto Lent Rise Road.

Continue straight over all mini-roundabouts. You will pass Burnham Memorial Cricket Ground on your right and Grovefield House on your left.

At the T-junction, the main gates of Cliveden are directly opposite. Follow the gravel drive all the way to the House, following signs for House Guests.

If travelling along the A4 from Maidenhead follow this road towards Slough and take the left hand turn onto Berry Hill, before the BMW garage, following signs towards Cliveden. Take this road for approx. three miles until you reach the main gate for Cliveden on your left hand side.

DIRECTIONS FROM M40

Exit M40 at Junction 2, at the roundabout get in the right hand lane and follow the A355 to Slough. After 150 yards turn right, which will take you past the Jolly Woodman public house, turn right into Wooburn Common Road, and the left onto Heathfield Road. Cliveden is two miles from there.

Please note: In the event that the main gates are closed, please press the blue 'call' button to speak to Porte Cochére. Alternatively please turn left out of the main entrance onto Cliveden Road and take the first left onto Bourne End Road. Continue on this road for approximately 300 metres where Hedsor Gate is located on the left. If these gates are also closed, please use the intercom system and one of our footmen will open the gate.

BY TRAIN

Nearest mainline station is Burnham, approximately four miles away. Trains from London Paddington, 30 minutes.

BY AIR

London Heathrow, 20 minutes by car. London Gatwick, 50 minutes by car or 20 minutes by helicopter.

BY HELICOPTER

A helipad is available on the estate. Please call us for details.


- 1. The Charges shall be paid to the Company in consideration for the use by the Guest of the Reserved Rooms during the Period. Any additional requirements and services, whether stated above or otherwise notified to the Company, shall be agreed and charged separately. [The Charges include a contribution to the National Trust.]
- 2. (a) A non-refundable deposit shall be paid to the Company to secure the booking.
 - (b) The balance of the Charges shall be paid in full to the Company no less than 14 days prior to the start of the event and otherwise in such installments and at such times as agreed with the Company.
- 3. The amount of the Expected Food and Drink Expenditure is an estimate, calculated in accordance with the number of guests. If the Guest incurs a higher food and drink bill than has been estimated, the difference shall be paid by credit card on the date of departure, together with any other outstanding charges. If the total food and drink bill is lower than estimated and the Expected Food and Drink Expenditure is not stated to be a "minimum spend" above, then the difference shall be reimbursed to the Guest on leaving the venue, subject to the Company's right to set off any such amount against any other outstanding sums owed by the Guest.
- 4. Please note all food and beverage consumed during your stay will be subject to a 10% discretionary service charge added to your bill. This excludes food and beverage items already included within your package rate.
- 5. On arrival at the Venue, the Guest will be required to provide details of a valid credit card (Card). In the event that any additional charges incurred in connection with this agreement are not paid to the Company on the date of departure, or as otherwise agreed by the parties, the Guest hereby authorises the Company to deduct all outstanding sums from the Card.
- 6. If the Guest wishes to cancel the reservation, written notice must be given to the Company (Cancellation Notice). A cancellation fee (Cancellation Fee) may be charged in accordance with the following provisions of this clause:
 - (a) If the Cancellation Notice is received by the Company 60 days or more but less than 90 days before the start of the Event Date, the Cancellation Fee will be 50% of the charges;
 - (b) If the Cancellation Notice is received by the Company 30 days or more but less than 60 days before the start of the Event Date, the Cancellation Fee will be 75% of the charges;

- (c) If the Cancellation Notice is received by the Company less than 30 days before the start of the Event Date, the Cancellation Fee will be 100% of the charges. The amount of any Cancellation Fee due shall be deemed to be reduced by the amount of any payments already made by the Guest. The Cancellation fee shall be paid to the Company within 14 days of the date of the notice requesting such.
- 7. The Company may terminate this agreement forthwith on written notice in the event that:
 - (a) The Guest enters into liquidation or bankruptcy, has a receiver or administrative receiver appointed, or enters into any arrangement for the benefit of its creditors; or
 - (b) A part of or all of the Venue is closed or rendered unavailable due to a cause beyond the Company's control and such closure or unavailability renders the Company unable to perform its obligations under this agreement.
- 8. The Company reserves the right to substitute the Reserved Rooms with different rooms in the Venue if, due to circumstances beyond the Company's control, one or more of the Reserved Rooms become unavailable.
- 9. In the event of any termination by the Company pursuant to clause 6 above, the Company shall be under no liability to the Guest for any loss of profit, loss of goodwill, loss of business, loss of opportunity or any special, indirect or consequential damage suffered by the Guest in consequence of the termination (this shall be without prejudice to any rights of either party against the other in respect of any claim accrued under this agreement down to the date of such termination). Nothing in this agreement shall limit or exclude liability for death or personal injury resulting from negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation.
- 10. Subject to clause 8, the Company's total liability arising under or in connection with this agreement, whether in tort, contract, misrepresentation, restitution or otherwise, shall be limited to the amount of the Charges.
- 11. Within seven days of the occurrence of any damage to the Property or injury to any person on the Property during the Period that is in any way the fault of the Guest or any other person at the Venue expressly or impliedly with his authority, the Guest must make good the same or pay to the Company or the person injured full compensation in money for such damage.
- 12. The Company retains control, possession and management of the Venue at all times and the Guest has no right to exclude the Company from the Venue. The Guest must not impede in any way the Company or its officers, employees or agents in the exercise of the Company's rights of possession and control of the Venue.

- 13. The Guest acknowledges that no relationship of landlord and tenant is created or intended to be created between the Company and the Guest by this agreement.
- 14. The Guest must abide by any specific rules and regulations set by the Company or by any regulatory authority and must comply with the terms of any licenses in place relating to the Venue, including but not limited to premises licenses and licenses for the playing of music.
- 15. The Guest may not assign or sublicense the whole or any part of the rights conferred by this agreement, which are personal to the Guest.
- 16. The Guest must not do anything at the Venue in such a way as to cause damage to the Venue or nuisance, annoyance, disturbance, inconvenience, injury or damage to the Company or its tenants or the owners or occupiers of adjacent or neighbouring property.
- 17. The Guest must keep the Company fully indemnified against all losses arising directly or indirectly out of any act, omission or negligence of the Guest, or any persons at the Venue expressly or impliedly with his authority, or any breach or non-observance by the Guest of the obligations, conditions or other provisions of this agreement.
- 18. The Guest must not do or omit to do anything that could cause any insurance policy on or in relation to the Venue to become wholly or partly void or voidable, or do or omit anything by which additional insurance premiums may become payable.
- 19. Any notice under this agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered by hand or sent by recorded delivery post, in the case of the Company to the address of the Venue for the attention of the Events Consultant named within and in the case of the Guest to the address stated at the beginning of this agreement for the attention of The Account & Contact named within. A notice delivered by hand is deemed to have been received when delivered (or if delivery is not in business hours, 9:00am on the first business day following delivery). A correctly addressed notice sent by recorded delivery post shall be deemed to have been received two business days following the date of posting.
- 20. We reserve the right to charge interest on overdue accounts at the rate of the prevailing Barclays Base Rate plus 8%, from the date that the balance became due for payment until payment is received to settle the balance in full.
- 21. VAT- In the event of any change in the taxation beyond the Hotel's control (e.g. Increase in the rate of VAT), the Hotel may vary the price quoted to any extent which reflects the change. All prices are subject to change without notice this agreement has been entered into on the date of signature of it.
